



L.E.A.P. – Logerquist Excellent Attitude Program (LEAP) is a social skills therapy group designed to help children and adolescents who have difficulty making and maintaining friends. Social skills are presented in one hour sessions, once a week. A small group format allows Dr. Logerquist to provide individualized support to each participant. Many people experience difficulties with social skills including those persons diagnosed with ADHD, Asperger's Syndrome and Anxiety.

Benefits for Participants

- **Identify** personal strengths and weakness relative to social skills
- **Gain** awareness of strengths and how to use them in social situations
- **Gain** skills to eliminate weaknesses
- **Receive** modeling and coaching of critical social skills needed for successful social interactions
 - Nonverbal Skills
 - Problem Solving Skills
 - Conversation Skills
- **Practice** these critical skills in a confidential group setting.
- **Refine** skills with feedback from Dr. Logerquist to insure optimal performance in social environments
- **Balance** emotions – gain strategies to address social anxiety and anger
- **Experience** positive reactions to their social interactions
- **Increase** self recognition of newly acquired skills

Benefit to Parents

- **Gain** information regarding social skill development
- **Gain** strategies to facilitate follow through of newly acquired skills.
- **Receive** materials and explanation to help promote social skills at home.
