This seminar will present the foundational sensory motor skills that develop during prenatal and neonatal time periods. Five key principles will be discussed for building a solid sensory motor foundation. This information can be applied to create environments that will enhance children's development. Considerations in building these environments include lighting, sound, play surfaces, and toys. While the focus will be on babies in the first year of life, the principles are applicable to older children as well. The practical activities can also be used to enhance the bonding process between parent and child.
