

## Comparison between NDF and NDF-Plus

NDF	NDF-Plus
<b>Ingredients</b>	
Nanonized chlorella, cilantro, probiotics, Vitae, grain neutral spirits.	Nanonized chlorella, cilantro, probiotics, Vitae, grain neutral spirits, and 25% probiotic predigested <b>drainage and organ support</b> : agaricus blazei, reishi, cordyceps, milk thistle seeds and horsetail. More fulvic acid complexes.
<b>Application</b>	
Patients with more recent onset of toxicity, normal constitutional strength.	Chronic, debilitated patients; low battery focus / rouleaux, high stress.
<b>Effects</b>	
Raises beta wave amplitude	Raises both beta and theta wave amplitudes
	More pronounced effect on neurological problems
<b><i>Mobilize predominantly via the urine</i></b>	
Both mobilize and bind to all known heavy metals, also chlorine, and most likely other chemicals, pesticides, endotoxins, mycotoxins and plaque which may complicate their use as a HMT challenge dose.	
<b>Dosage</b>	
6 drops BID or up to 2 droppers full (52 drops) twice a day.	5-10 drops a day. Some do well with more.
Both are taken with 10 oz r/o or distilled water at the time of the dose, additional water taken until the second urine following the dose, and then switch to an alkaline water thereafter. Amount of dose is discovered by ramping up. No healing crisis required.	
<b>Results</b>	
Faster detox, dose related	Slower detox, dose related
<b>Contraindications</b>	
Anuria, renal failure, acute conditions except for metal poisoning, pregnancy or nursing, states of hyper arousal. With amalgam fillings, brush and spit and rinse with either before the dose. No auto-urine therapy during detox.	
<b>Caution</b>	
May bind to and inactivate certain Western pharmaceutical drugs.
